On behalf of ALBA, the Spanish Association of People with Albinism, here I detail the activities and events that we will celebrate on the International Albinism Awareness Day 13th of June 2018 in SPAIN:

- On June 13th we will make public the short film ¿Lo ves? by Patty Bonet for free disposal. The announcement will be done at the Facebook page of Flare Producciones https://www.facebook.com/flareproducciones/?ref=br_rs The short film shows daily situations faced by a person with albinism shot with a subjective camera technique so the viewers will put themselves in the shoes of a person that faces situations with visual limitations.
- The digital newspaper Huffington Post will publish a report about albinism with Javier Andres, a board member of ALBA. Also, the TV show “El Tiempo” will interview him to see how weather affects people with albinism.
- We’re coordinating and taking part of the campaign “I Look Out of Albinism” that this year will be launched by Albinism Europe supported by different associations as a worldwide action inviting people from all over the world to take a selfie or video with their finger pointing their eye, and post it to social media with the hashtag #ILookOutForAlbinism showing that they care about people with albinism.
